 - Jesus Explains to his close friends


Our frame of mind will contribute to our fruitfulness any day any situation on Monday (tomorrow)

HARD PATH MINDSET:

Mind made up and set as concrete

Mind is fixed/set

- on other issues that bother us, or
- •we strongly believe we are "right"!!
- by deep hurts we can't forgive

Result

- not open to what is in-front of us/ being shared
- a road to joyless, grim determination or bitterness
- We switch off & not give anything a chance to stick

- Fits of anger and frustration
- Predjudices
- or even envy......

Root of such hard thinking?

•We are sitting in the JUDGEMENT seat on others

Bible Examples of hard path mindset in action

- The Pharisees (plotting to Kill the Messiah)
- Pharoah (Moses time "set his face as flint")

Get out of the "judgement seat"

(The Father gives that all to Jesus)

Instead - take the "Mind of Christ"

"consider others better than yourself"

..... EVERYONE 😊


Antidote in Scripture: Phillipians 2 v 1-11

Our Thinking is scorched and becomes dry



ROCKY, THIN SOIL MINDSET: Our Thinking is scorched and becomes dry

Our Minds/thinking are scorched by

- stresses and conflicts at work/home/school
- fear and dread of the future or people
- doubting
- out of control hurts

Fruits in our lives

- No peace of mind
- Hypocritical behaviours start up again

In the heat of it, we behave as though we weren't a Christian

ROCKY, THIN SOIL MINDSET:

Our Thinking is scorched and becomes dry

"Tell-tale" signs?

- Anxious or distracted
- Irritable
- Repeated backsliding into old ways of behaving

Root of such scorched, thin soil thinking?

We forget....

where our security is: in God who we are "in Christ", So we forget to trust JESUS

Bible Examples of scorched, "thin soil" mindset in action

- Apostle Peter denying Jesus (fear)
- "Doubting" Thomas (after resurrection)

Rocky, thin soil "Cure" © for more fruitfulness

"Build your house upon the Rock, not upon the sand"

- "Trust and obey"
- With thanksgiving,
 - cast all cares to Jesus in prayer

The Peace of God will keep our hearts and minds i.e. refreshed (not scorched)

THORNY SOIL MINDSET:

Our thinking becomes choked by

- Unhealthy fixation on something e.g. wealth
- Over indulging in an activity greed
- Out of control desires e.g. lust/porn habit

Results

- Blaming / unforgiveness of yourself
- Shame
- We become takers and not givers in relationships

THORNY SOIL MINDSET:

A mind taken over by other things

"Tell-tale" signs?

- Activities done "in secret" when we are alone
- Lack of joy / and tasks become a duty
- We begin to feel "detached"

Root of such thorn-choked thinking?

Feeding our desires

Bible Examples of thorn-choked thinking in action?

- King David, (with Bathsheba & then Uriah)
- Rich young ruler (didn't join up with Jesus)

Reverse the flow of "feeding" our desires

- BE CONTENT with what we have
- Have a daily quiet time with Jesus
- Pray good on those you look being exploited online
- Be generous with time and money
- be self controlled
