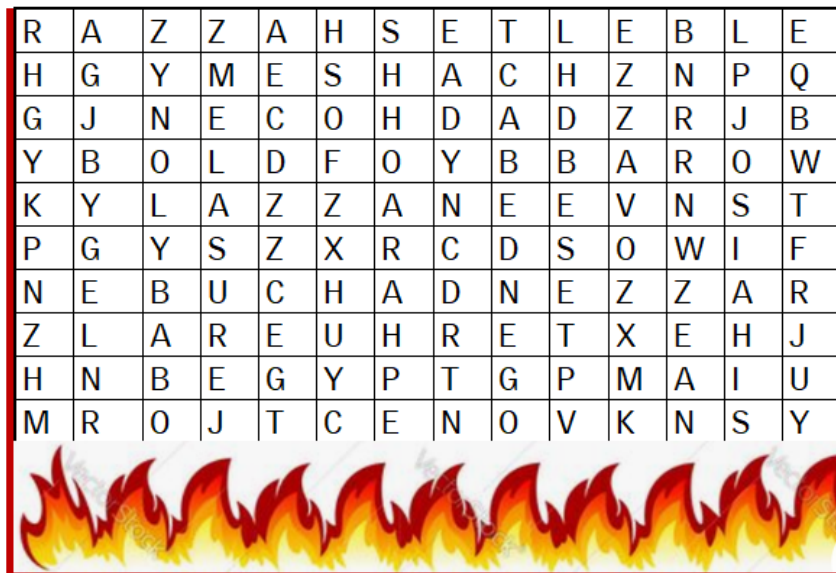


Shady & Mad Neb Worksheet

WORDSEARCH

In the Bible, these stories are found in Daniel chapters 3 and 4

Nebuchadnezzar, Belshazzar, Meshach, Abednego, Josiah and Neco were all characters in the story. Also mentioned was *Jerusalem, Babylon, Egypt and Pharaoh*. These ten words are hidden in the furnace below. Can you find them?



NICKNAMES

A Nickname is a familiar or funny name we call people, sometimes to show fondness or to make people laugh

In this story, new names were given to harm the way the boys felt about themselves. One way to help remember them is as follows:

Shadrach - Shake the bed; Meshach - Make the bed; Abednego - Into bed you go

What did you do with them - dip them in Egg yolk?

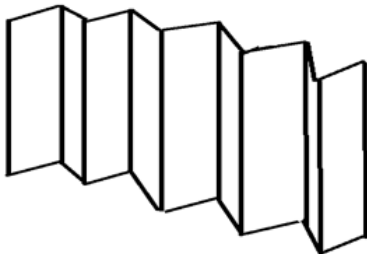
For this part you will need a piece of paper and some sharp scissors.



**To begin with, paint or colour the bottom of the sheet in a dark colour
(This is the burnt, or toasted bit)**

**Paint the sheet this way round
If you like, you can paint the top 15mm in a bright red or orange colour**

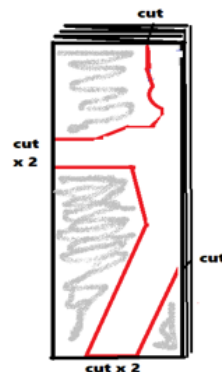
Then fold the sheet vertically into between 25-30mm wide columns



Fold as many as you can, then draw half a person as below and carefully cut it out through the whole folded sheets and throw away the shaded bits

When you have done all that, you can open the sheet out and see your own line of toast soldiers

You can try different shapes and see what other things you can make



Keep the dark shading at the bottom
