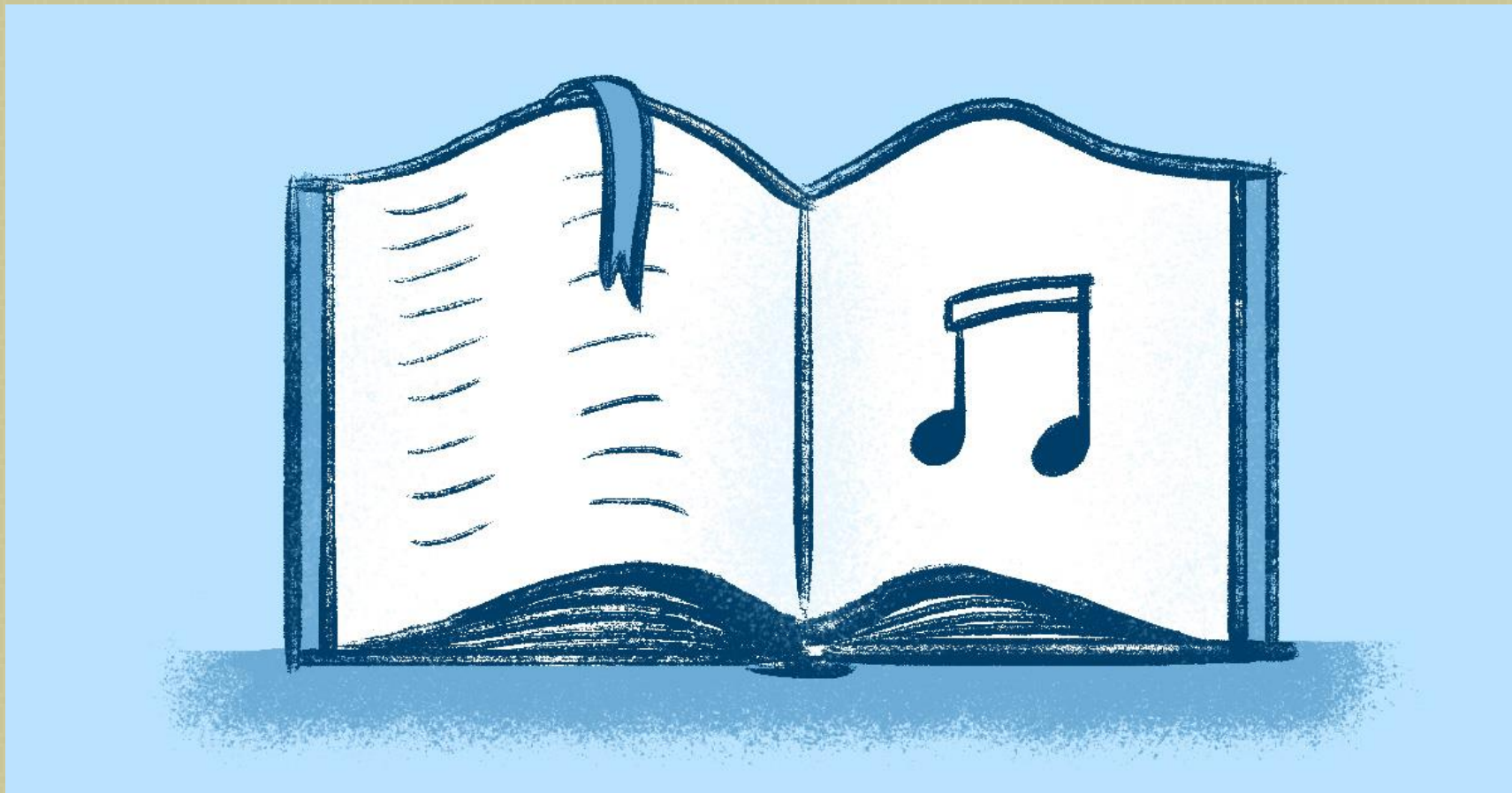

Zephaniah 3:14-17

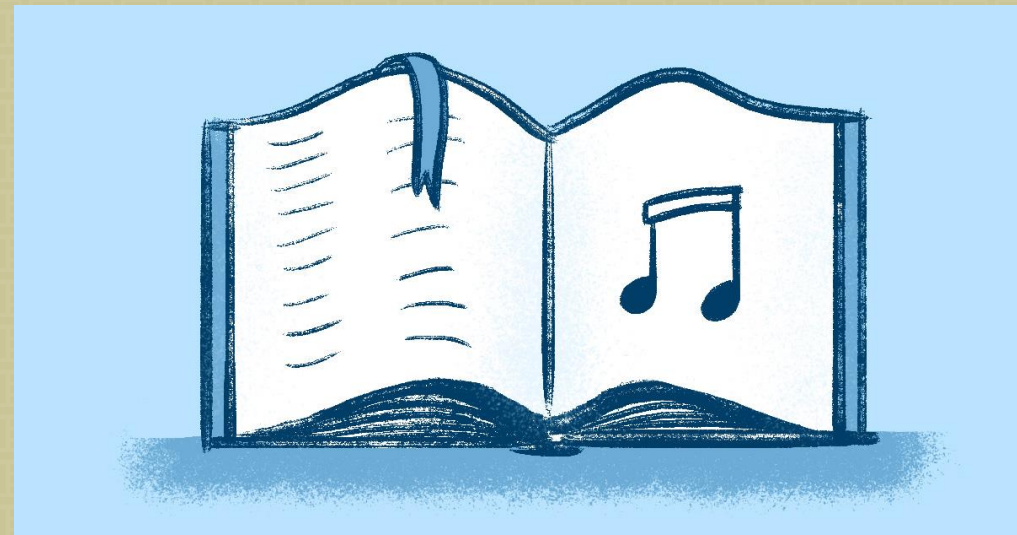
Sing, Daughter Zion; shout aloud, Israel! Be glad and rejoice with all your heart, Daughter Jerusalem!

On that day they will say to Jerusalem,

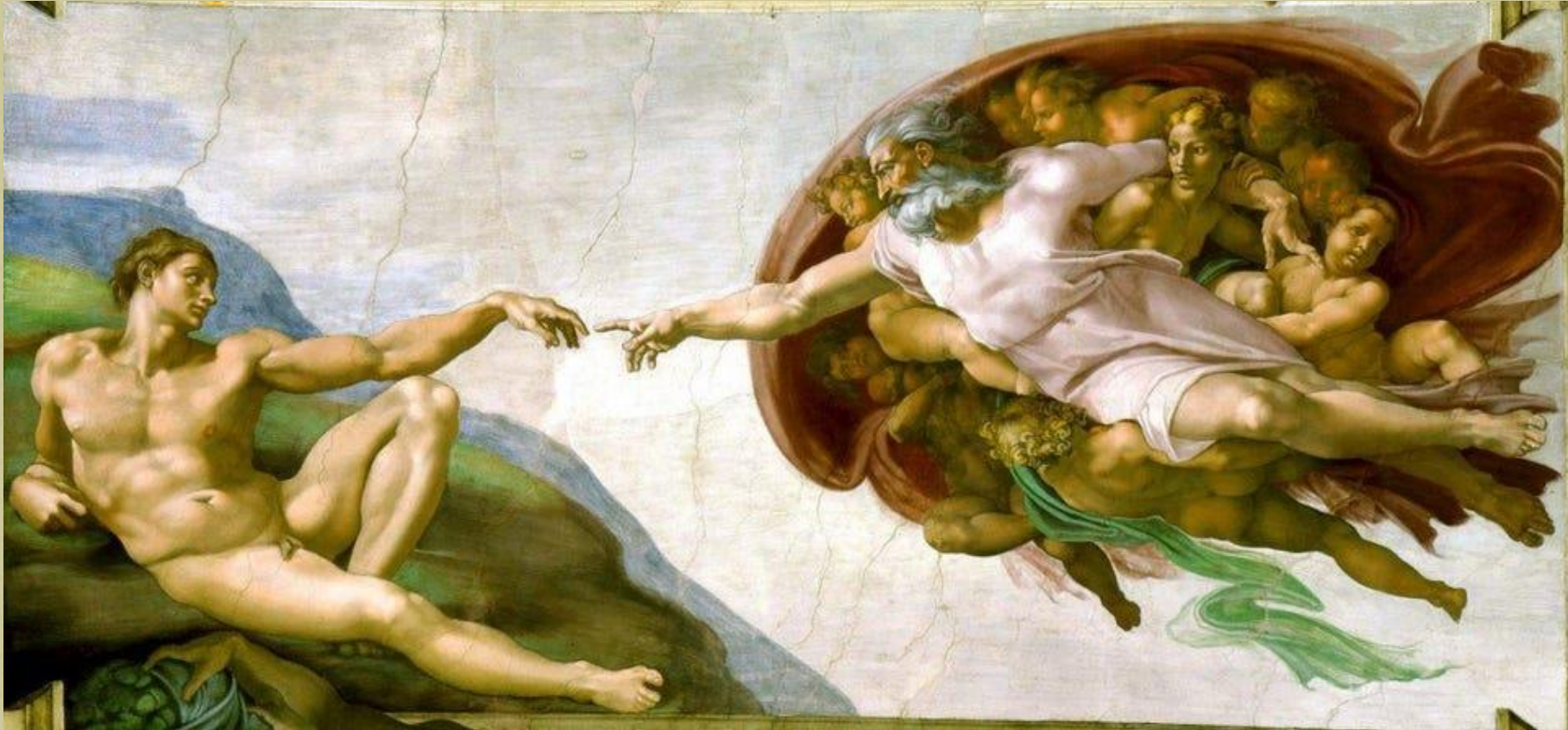

4. What do we learn about people?



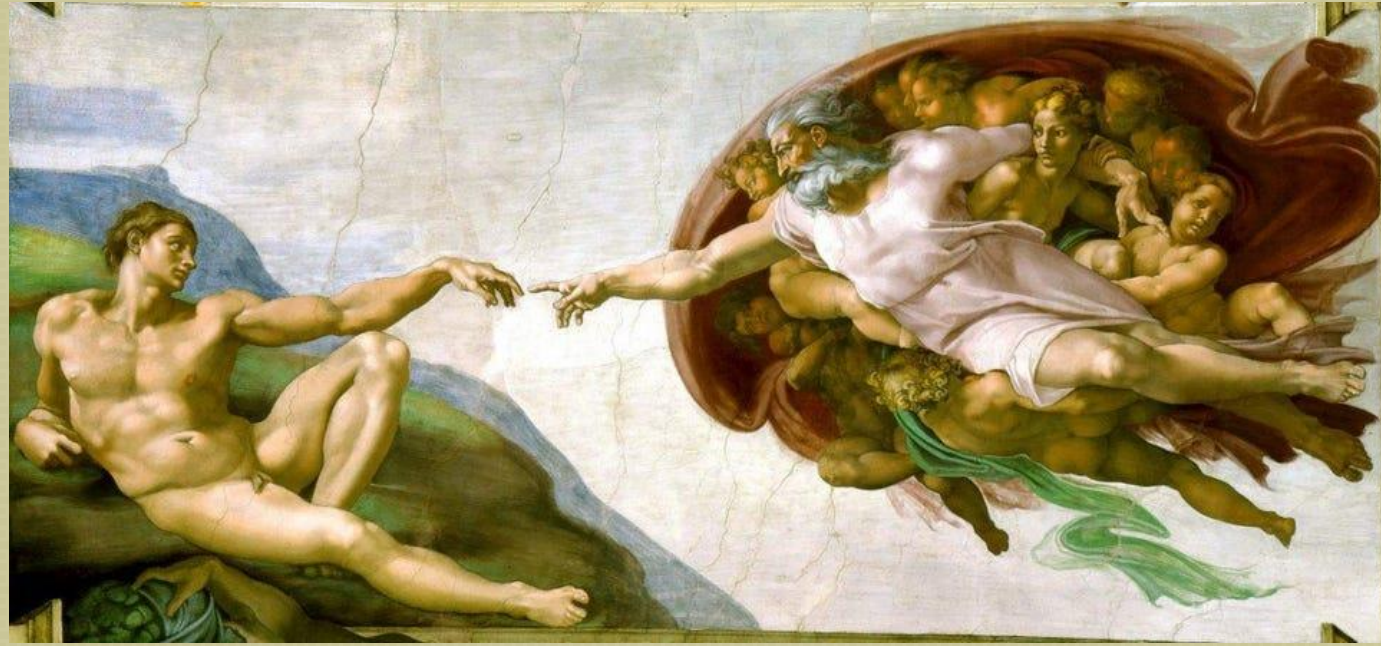
