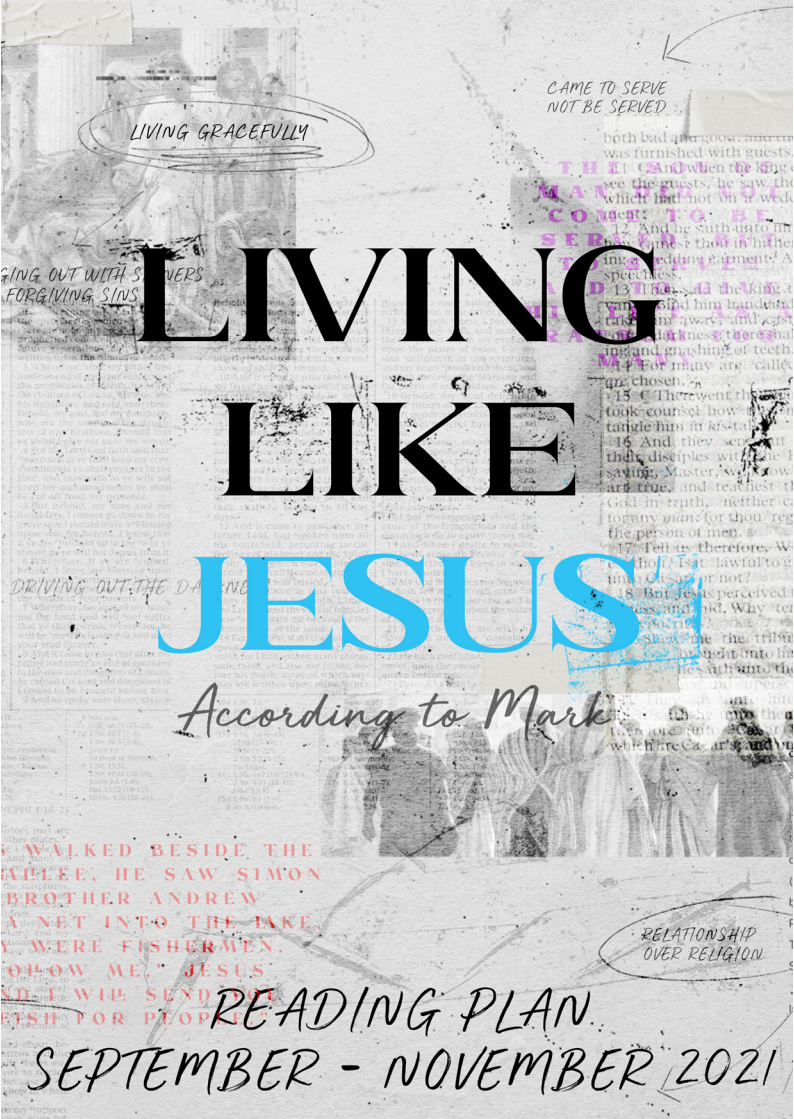

What's this about?

Jesus came that we might have abundant life. That's our Promised Land and we can enter into it through trusting our Father and following the example set by Jesus, the Son. We enter into life by copying Jesus, doing and saying the kinds of things Jesus did and said, by choosing to live like children of God. Of course, we're not God and Jesus is. So we may not get a booming voice from heaven saying, "You are my beloved Son", but we get the inner voice of the Spirit helping us cry out, "Abba, Father". We don't get a glorious transfiguration (not till the final Day), but we do get to be transformed from one degree of glory to another as we choose to humble ourselves and lay down our lives for others. Incredibly, we don't just get to do the kinds of things Jesus did, but He promised us we would do greater things if we trusted Him. So, if we really want to bring the life of Jesus wherever we are, we've got to live like Jesus ... and this series will help us do just that, using readings from the Gospel of Mark.

When is this happening?

'Living Like Jesus' begins on Monday 13th September and will finish on Sunday 28th November. Throughout the series, a weekly email will be sent out early on a Monday morning with the week's Bible readings, each linked to the day's Scripture.

TIPS FOR STUDY & REFLECTION

PRAY:

Holy Spirit, as I read these Scriptures today, please teach me how to live even more like Jesus.

READ:

What does the passage say? (Try reading it in different translations.)

ASK:

What does the passage mean? (A good Bible commentary can help.)

APPLY:

- What is Jesus revealing to us about Who He is
- What changes can I make to be more like Him?
